at the meeting, including the state's budget for the next year and also clear foundations were established to continue governing in a coordinated way.

Osorio Chong praised the support and backing of the federal government for the State, headed by Jara, since the launch of the Michoacán Plan.

Officials said the meeting established the charge of the State's internal politics. At the press conference it was highlighted that the the plan needs to be implemented in coordination with the state authorities to ensure the safety of Michoacán and the integral development.
