

Gov. Mario Anguiano presentend new infrastructure projects in Ixtlahuacán municipality on Wedenesday.

Anguiano tours municipalities



On a job tour in Ixtlahuacán on Wednesday, Colima Gov. Mario Anguiano Moreno presented new projects of infrastructure, urban-

ization, drinking water, and waste water treatment plants.

The new investments will be in the communities of Las Conchas, Zinacamitlán, Plan de Zapote, Agua de la Virgen and Ixtlahuacán city, and will total 275 million pesos (\$2.1 million).

After introducing the "Program for Indigenous Rights by Supporting Community Initiatives and Justice", and speaking from the "Las Parotas" multi-use sports field, the governor said that he supports and admires the work done by the mayor of Ixtlahuacán to improve infrastructure in the municipality.

In order to supply clean drinking water to the population of Ixtlahuacán, water treatment systems were rehabilitated and new waste water treatment plants were constructed to replace faulty oxidation ponds that gave off bad odors.

"Today Ixtlahuacán has a more efficient water treatment plant," said Anguiano, "because we did not squander the opportunity to improve conditions and benefit the public."

The governor said that the city of Ixtlahuacán alone received 10 million pesos (\$765,465) for water treatment and infrastructure projects.

Anguiano also gave credit to President Enrique Peña Nieto and federal entities such as the National Water Commission (Conagua) and the Secretariat of Social Development (Sedesol) for implementing programs that benefit the citizens of Mexico.

State Secretary of Urban Development Fernando Morán Rodríguez said that the infrastructure projects have a direct impact on the public. He said that in the communities of Zinacamitlán and Plan de Zapote new pavement was laid for roads and sidewalks, and in Ixtlahuacán City more than 4,000 meters of sidewalks were constructed in the Carlos de la Madrid and Daniel Contreras neighborhoods to meet priority needs.
