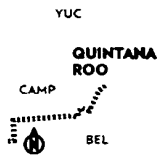

State and Sedesol sign cooperation deal



Governor Roberto Borge Angulo and federal Social Development Secretary Rosario Robles Berlanga signed the Inapam State Government Cooperation Agreement Wednesday and officially swore in the Community Committees of the National Crusade Against Hunger event.

The governor was accompanied by his wife, Mariana Zorrilla de Borge, at the event at the Isla Mujeres Hall in the International Center of Business and Conventions.

"The agreement we signed merges the efforts between state and federal governments with the aim of giving older people more benefits and so helping their integral human development," said Borge.

Aracely Escalante Jasso, the general director of the National Institute for the Elderly (Inapam), also signed the agreement and participated in the symbolic action of handing out five PAL-No Hunger cards, which are part of the Opportunities Program (Oportunidades) of the Social Development Secretariat (Sedesol), to heads of household. Two life insurance policies were given out as well.

"The benefits received from the various programs, through Sedesol is reassurance that the government of Quintana Roo and its elderly citizens are in good hands and taken care of by the federal government and President Enrique Peña Nieto," Borge said.

The governor thanked Peña Nieto and Robles for all the support Quintana Roo has received.
